Stone churches were meant to withstand time but this one in the town of [Moalboal](#) did not. Well it did not because it was not made of stones in the first place.

Condemned due to structural defects, a part of the church — the one made of concrete hollow blocks — was torn down since it was already in the brink of collapse. Spared was the original 19th-century stone facade with a massive concrete belfry sitting on top of the pediment. Obviously, the ill-advised renovations in the past have caused this church to be in its current state.
